In conjunction with MYCAPSSA's approval, Chiasma is proud to announce the launch of CAPS – or Chiasma Access and Patient Support. CAPS is designed to provide patients with support and services that are unrivaled in the acromegaly treatment space. Through CAPS, each patient who consents will be assigned a dedicated case manager, who will be available to provide an array of support services ranging from assistance with insurance providers and specialty pharmacies to help with incorporating MYCAPSSA seamlessly into patients' daily lives. The CAPS team is ready to speak with patients now. In addition, Chiasma is planning to offer a mobile phlebotomy program, once MYCAPSSA is available, to allow blood draws to be performed away from medical facilities and deliver samples directly to labs to assist physicians with IGF-1 measurements and dose titration decisions.
